Waivers & Coggins

Waivers and proof of negative Coggins are mandatory for all riders. Go to the Trail Ride Signup page on our website to download the waiver. Please sign the waiver and make a copy of the Coggins for each rider and horse. You can also sign a waiver and bring a copy of Coggins on the day of the ride.

Riding Speeds and Required Level of Riding Skill

We want the ride to be accessible to virtually all levels of rider. We will break into as many groups as necessary to accommodate riders of all levels. We ask only that riders and mounts be generally comfortable riding outdoors. We anticipate a walk group, walk/trot group and a walk/trot/canter group.

The trail ride is FREE. There is no cost of any kind to participants.
